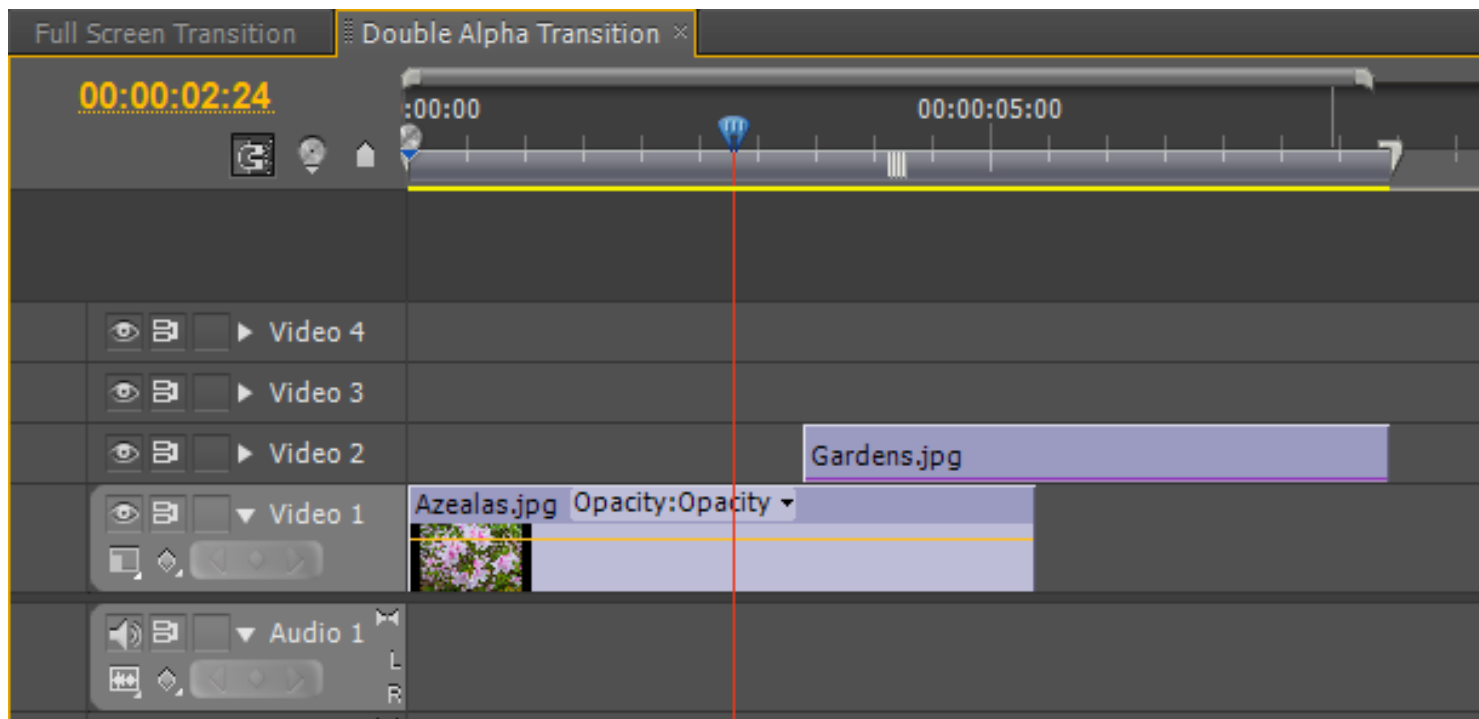


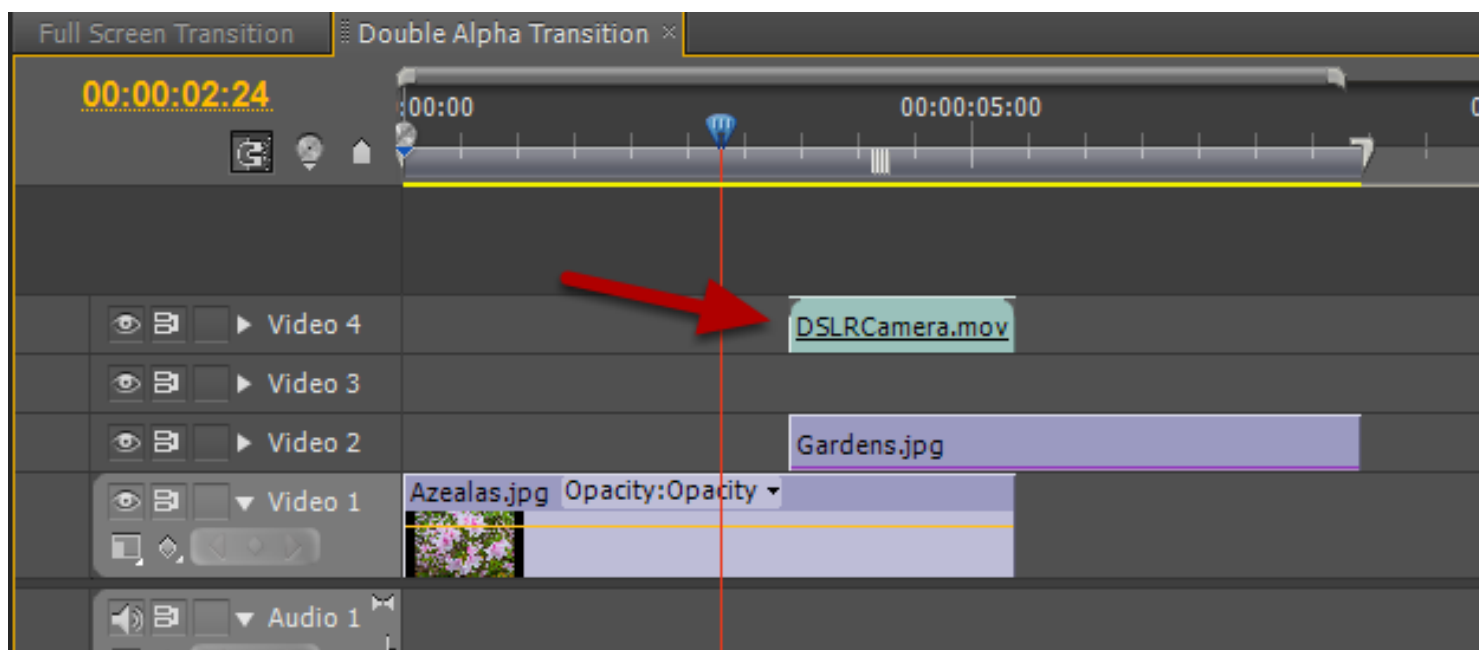
Using Digital Hotcakes Transitions with Track Mattes in Adobe Premiere Pro

1. Import your video or photos. Import Digital Hotcakes transition clip and matte clip.

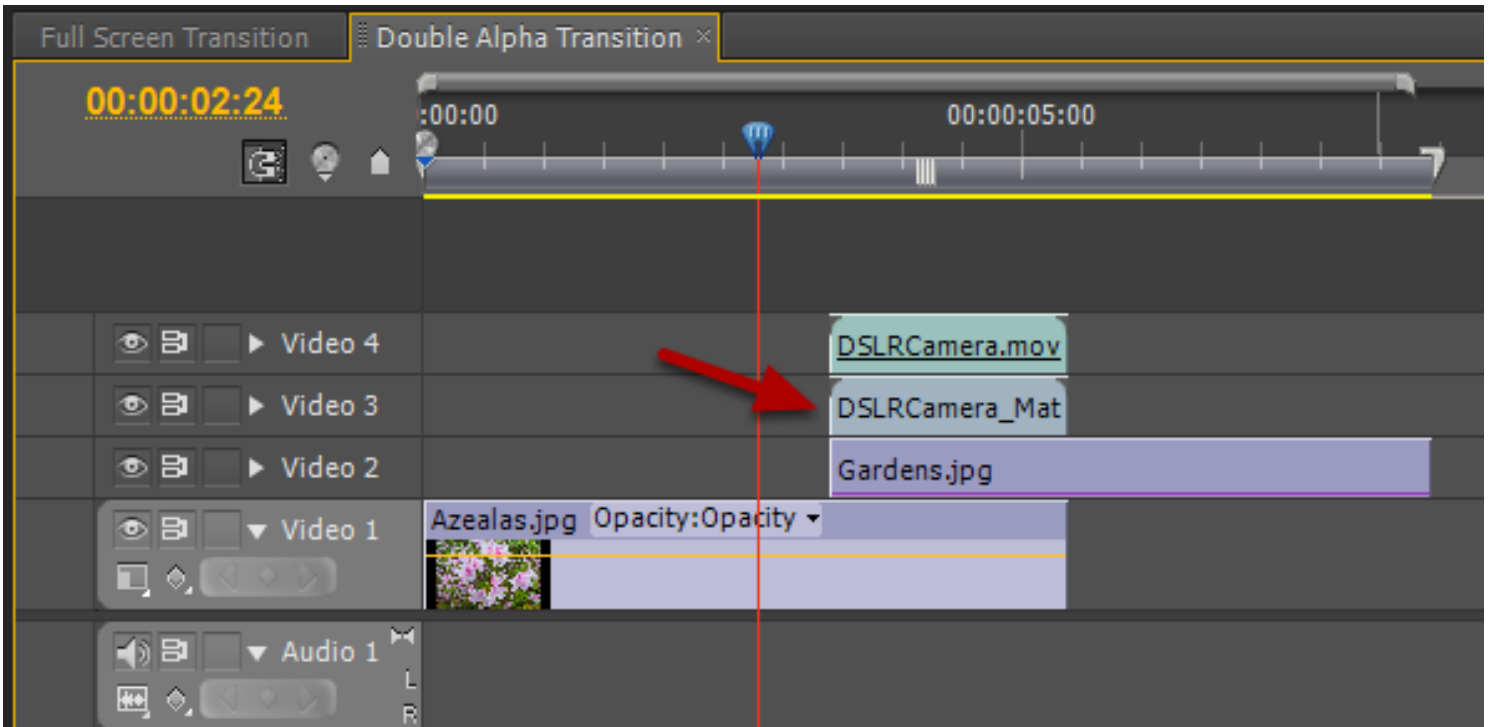
2. Place your outgoing clip on Video Track 1 and your incoming clip on Video Track 2 with some overlap.



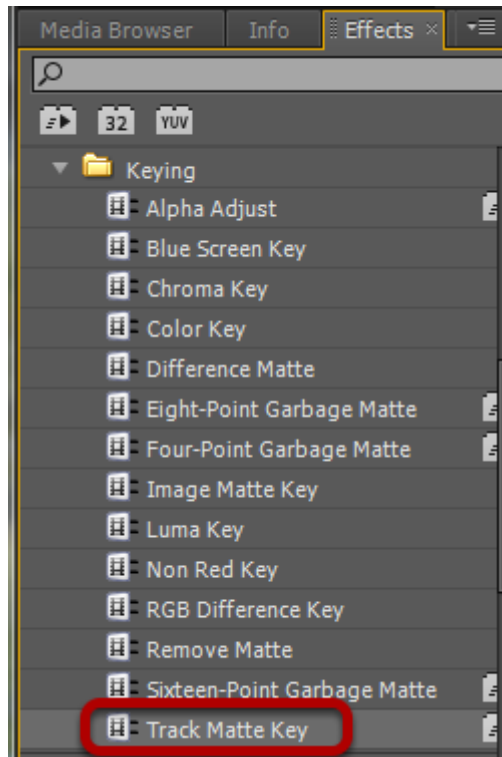
3. Place the transition clip on Video track 4 over incoming clip that's on Video track 2.



4. Place the transition matte clip on Video track 3 and line it up with transition clip.

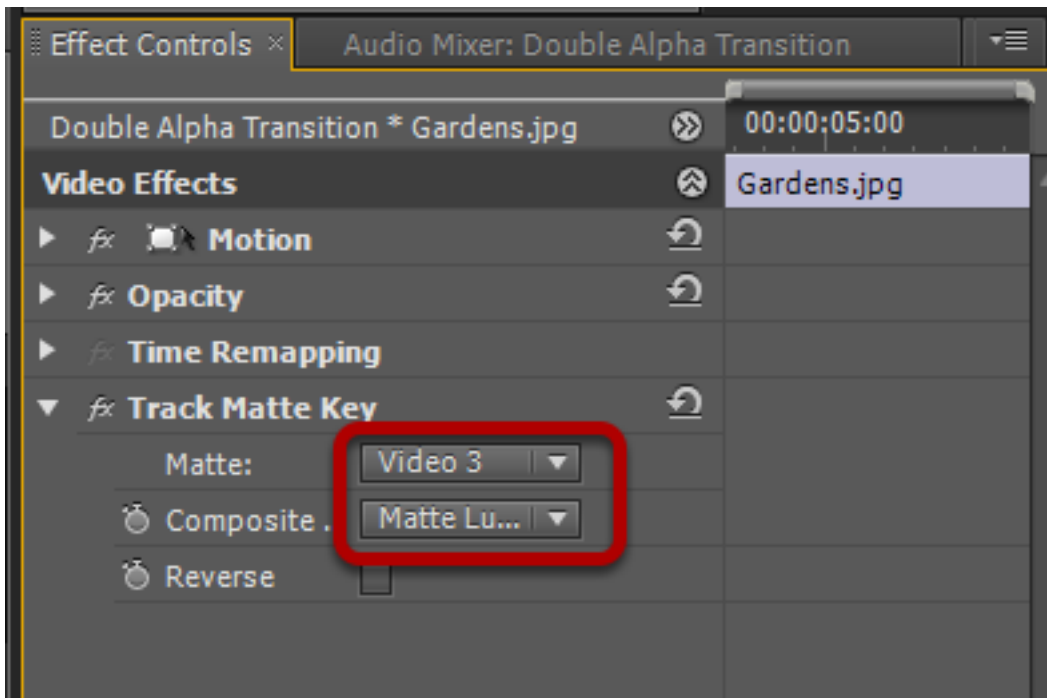


5. Apply a track matte keying effect to the clip in Video track 2

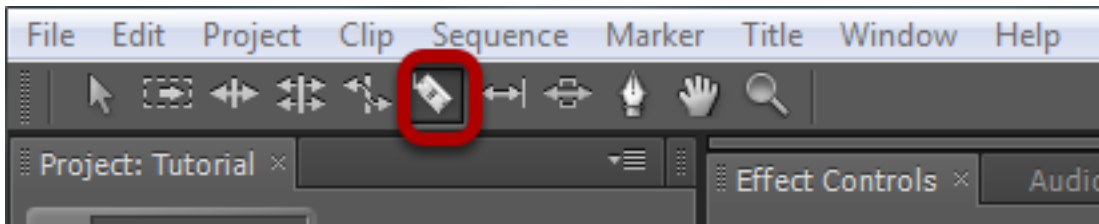


Drag Track Matte Key to clip on Video track 2.

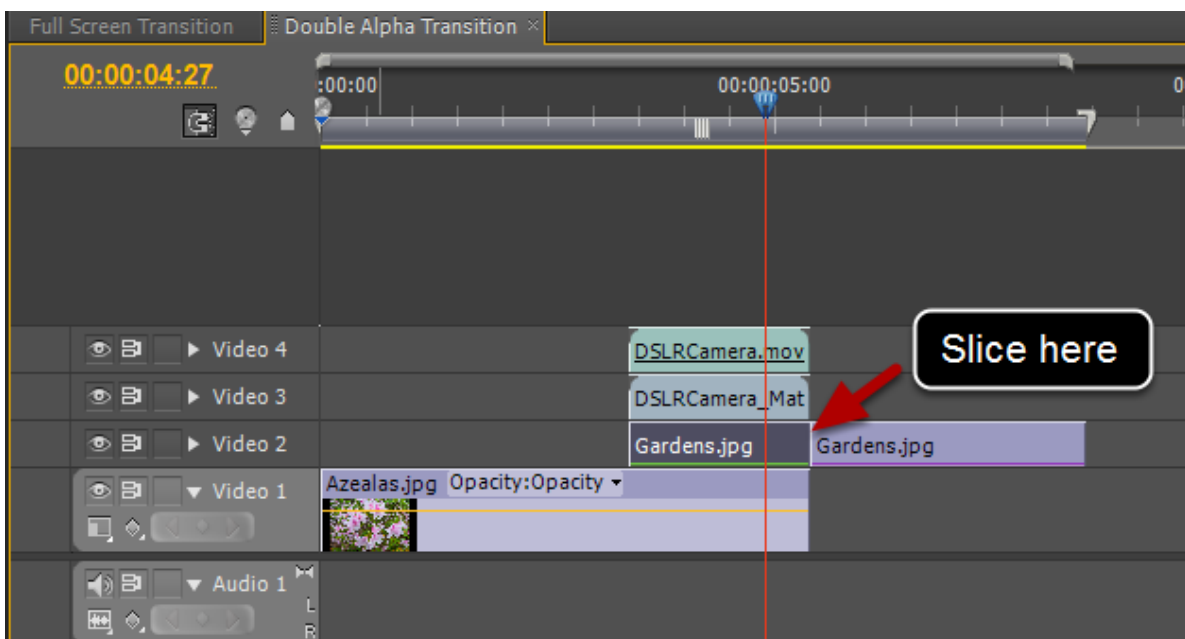
6. Set track matte to Video 3 and Composite to Matte Luma



7. Select Razor Tool (shortcut Hit letter C)

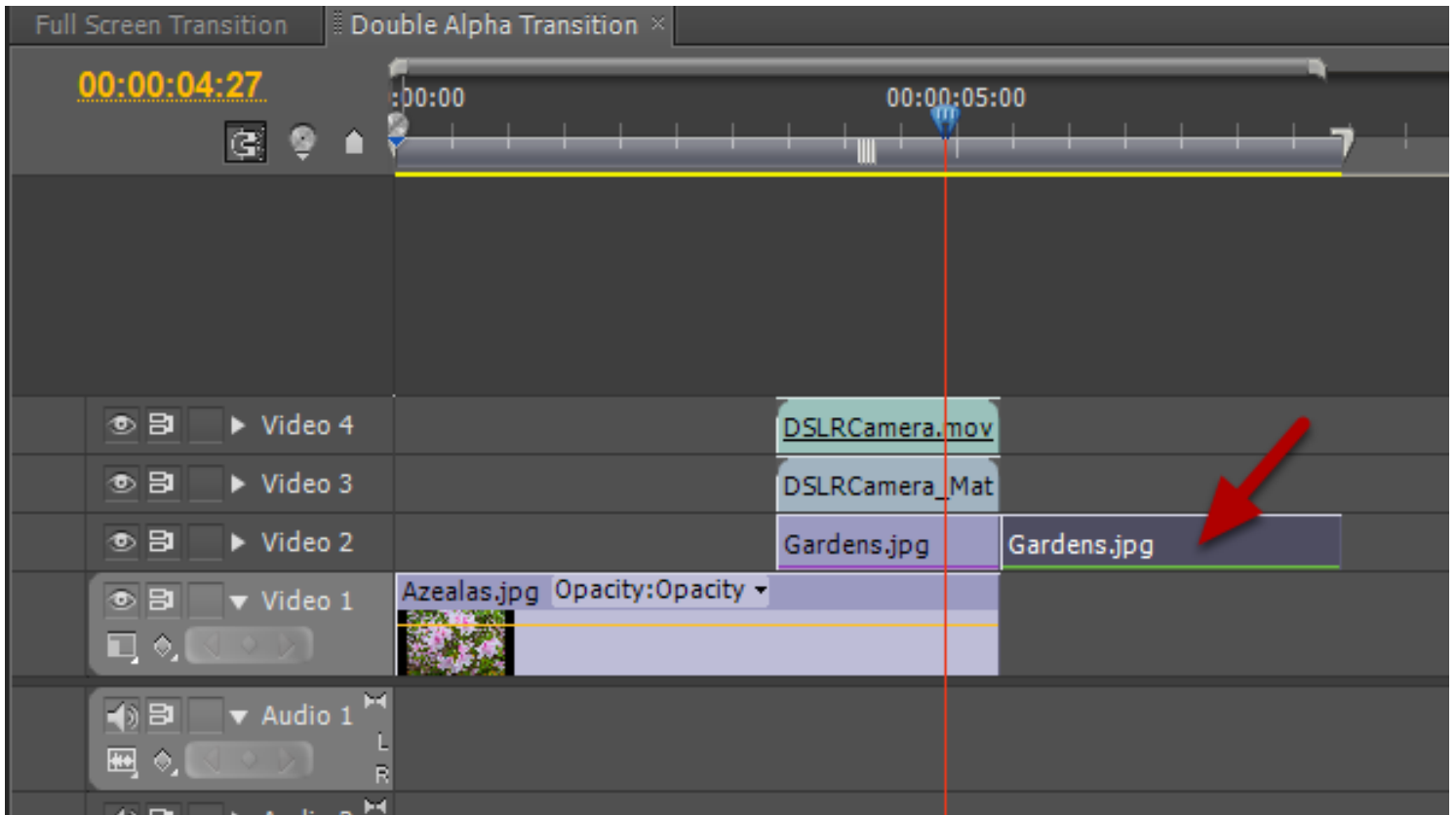


8. Slice clip in Video 2 at point where transition ends.

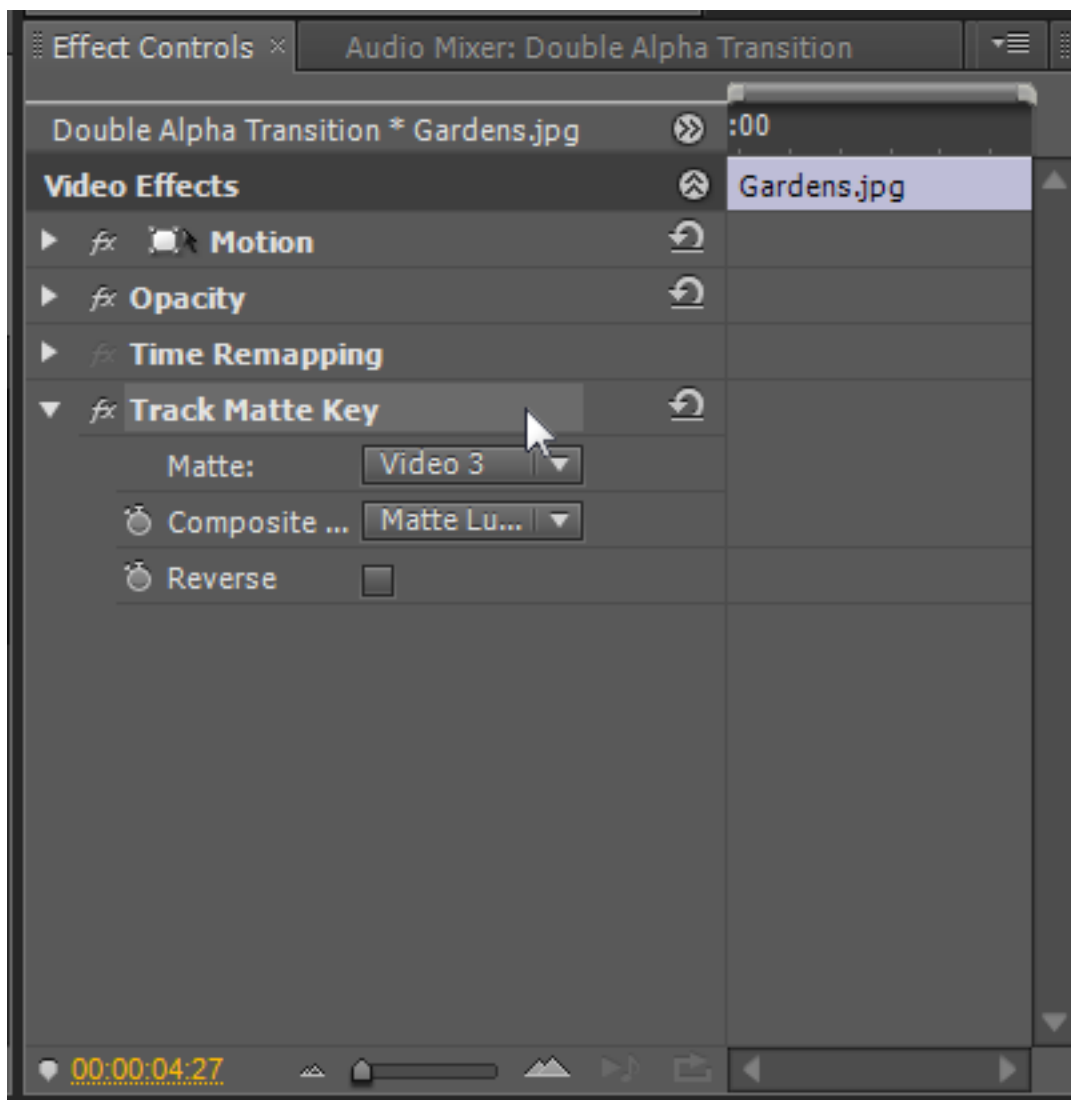


9. Hit letter V to change back to Selection tool.

10. Click on clip just sliced in Video track 2 to select it.



11. Remove the Track Matte effect



Click on Track Matte Key in Effects Controls and hit Delete key
